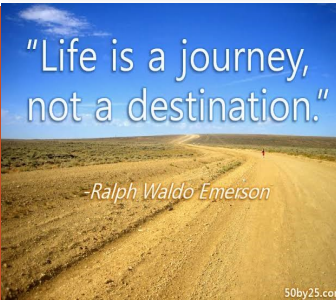
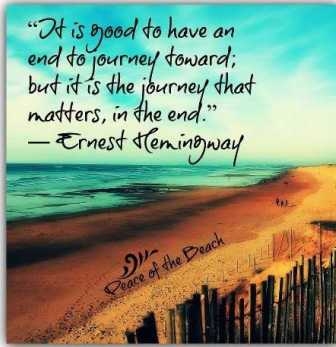
### Lokrang

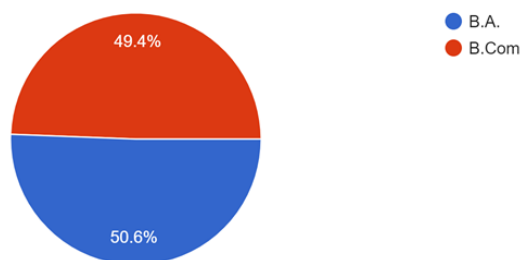

## A study on "Online Learning"

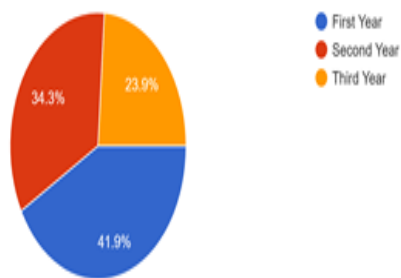

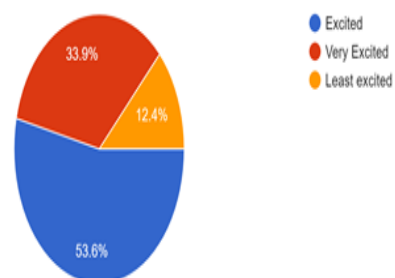

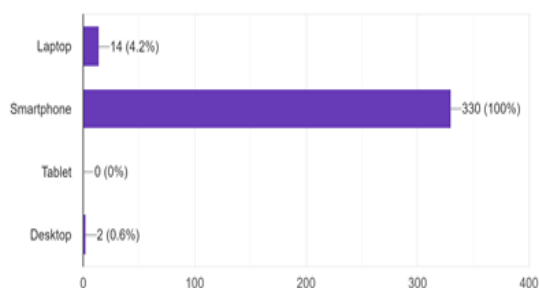
## 1) In the beginning of the academic year, how excited were you about attending online classes?

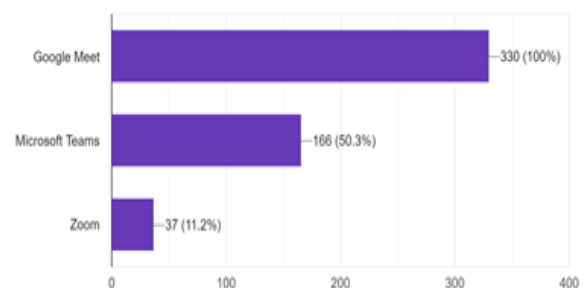
## 2) Which of the following devices did you use for online learning?

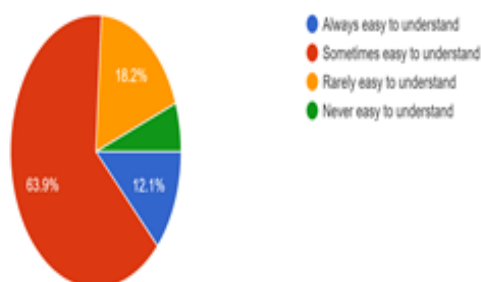
## 3) Choose two online learning tools that you have found easy to use:

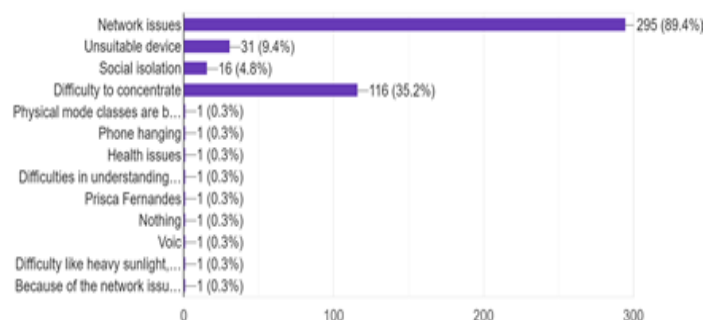
## 4) Were online classes easy to understand?

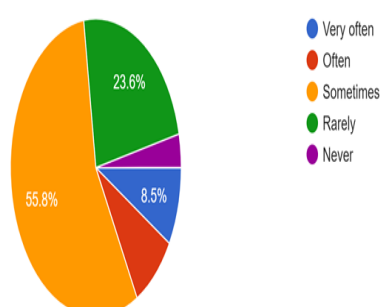
## 5) What difficulties did you face while attending online classes?

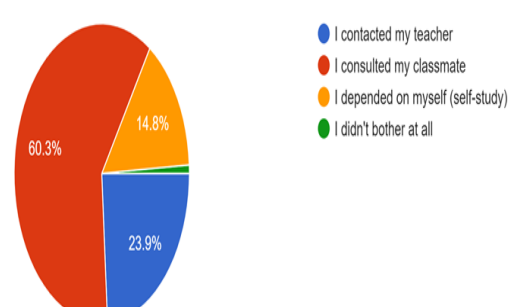
## 6) Were lectures/ practicals rescheduled by the teacher due to his/her connectivity issues?

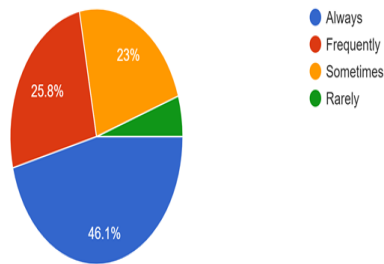
## 7) In case you didn't understand the teacher's explanation, what did you do?

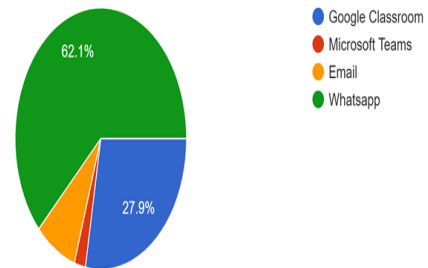
8) Did you get adequate learning material from your teachers?

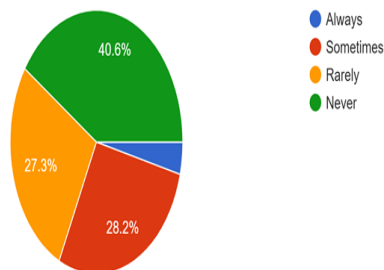
9) According to you, which is the best mode to receive study materials from teachers?

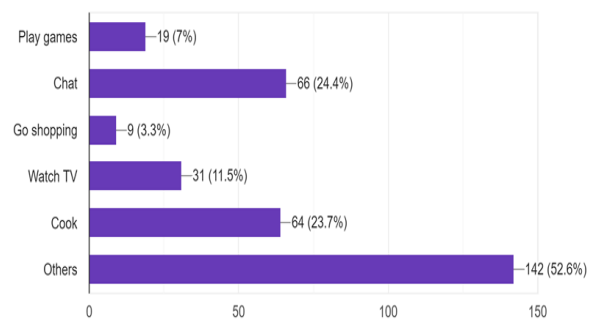
10) Are you a multitasker (doing more than one job at the same time) while attending online classes?

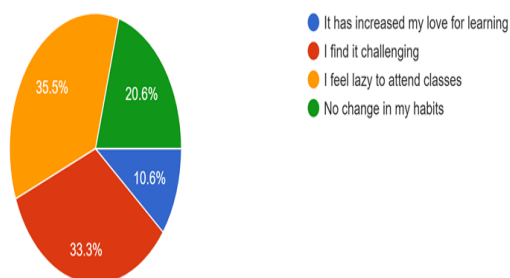
11) If you are a multitasker, which of the following tasks do you perform?

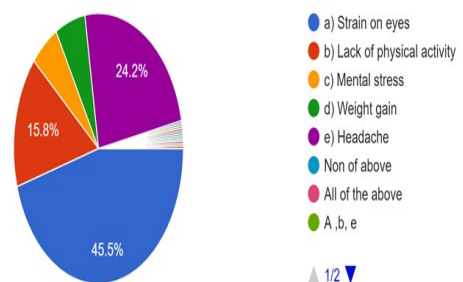
12) Impact of online learning on your study habits.

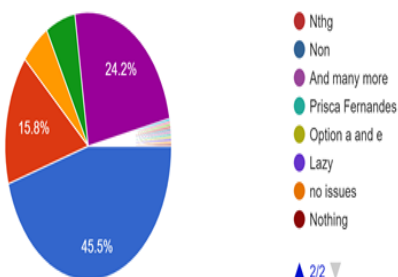
13) Health issues due to online teaching

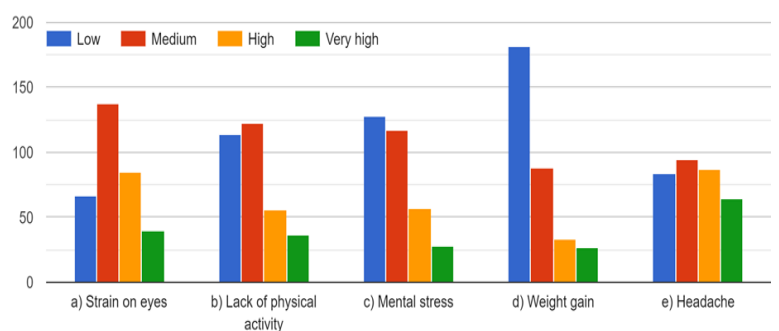

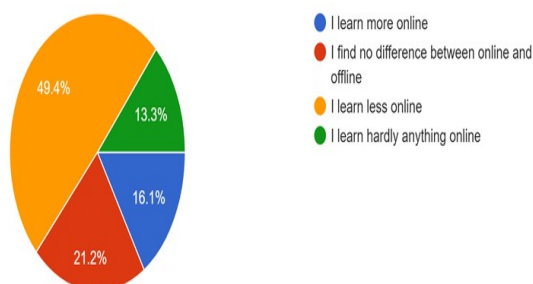


14) Intensity of health issues due to online teaching



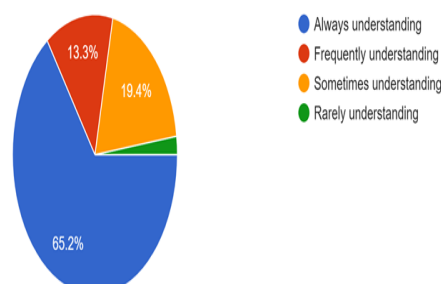
15) As compared to offline classes:

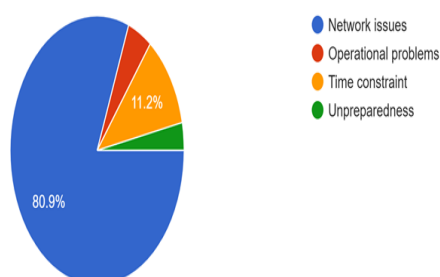
16) How understanding were your teachers regarding deadlines for submissions?

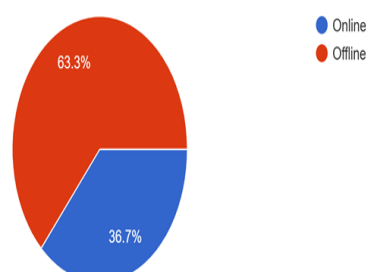
17) What were the difficulties faced during online exams?

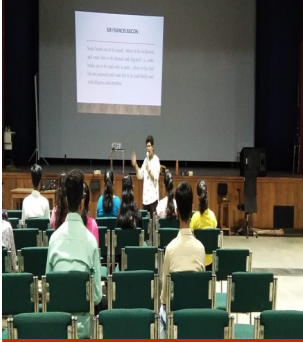

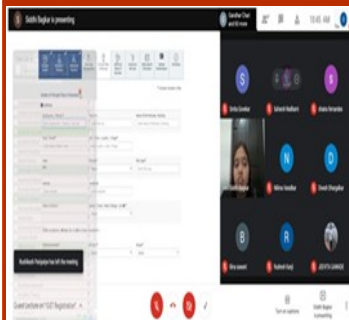
