75 Hours of Community Work for University and College Teachers Proposal for the Commemoration of 75 years of India's Independence

The idea behind this exercise is to inculcate in teachers a spirit of social responsibility beyond their regular work commitments, to collaborate with the local communities to identify problems and to find innovative solutions or even to share knowledge and ideas. This we believe is a token contribution to transform the country.

What we expect from all teachers* of the Goa University and its affiliated colleges:

- * by all teachers we include those on contract, temporary and lecture basis teachers as well. The duration of expected community work will be no less than an added 20 percent of the duration of the contract/ appointment. For example a teacher on a month (30 day) contract will be expected to do 20% of 30 days, that is, 6 hours of community work
 - 1. A total of 75 hours of community work beginning 15 August 2021 to 15 August 2022.
 - 2. Projects undertaken will not be funded by Goa University nor will any remunerated work be considered as Community Work.
 - 3. It is mandated that every teacher will submit an **individual** report on their community work done between 15 August of one year to 15 August of the next year.
 - 4. Teachers however may collaborate with other teachers from their department, other departments or even other institutions for community work

The report should contain: a) Table indicating the 75 hours and work done in brief, b) detailed description of expected outcome of work* (see suggested list below), c) account of work done with documented evidence, d) feedback/impact (which may be qualitative, quantitative or both)


