The Department of Geography of S.S.A Govt College of Arts and Commerce, Pernem has conducted a mandatory Environmental study field trip for F.Y.B.Com students (Div: A) on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 at Bondla Wildlife Sanctuary and Usgao mining region as a part of the EVS syllabus prescribed by Goa University.

The students were taken to Bondla Wildlife Sanctuary and Usgao mining region. Students were made to observe and note the Mining site were the destruction created on environment. Later the students reach to Bondla wildlife sanctuary, were the students observed the biodiversity features of Western Ghats. The students were taken inside the wild life sanctuary to observed the animals and species of plants. The teacher explained the students about the different features of forest biodiversity, the various species of birds, reptiles and wild animals. Further the students also observed the few species which are not found in Goa. These species were specially exported for Zoo purpose. The students were also advised to click a photo graph to prepare a field report. Altogether, there were 37 students attended the field trip.

The field trip helped the students in developing their Environmental concepts, elements through direct personal experiences. It enhanced their knowledge about human environment

relationship by understanding sensitivity about the place they visited. Mr. Adrel Gomes (Asst. Prof in Geography) accompanied the students for the study trip.


