That you are proud.

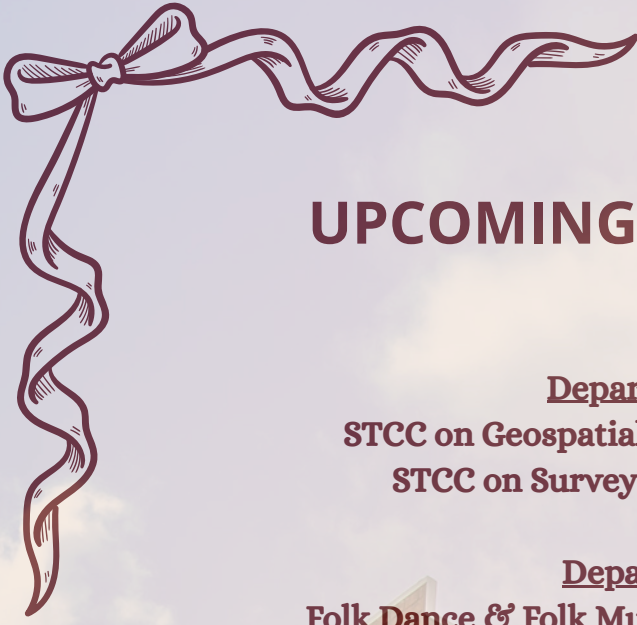
Take small steps,
